El proyecto W2B, que se desarrollará hasta finales de 2020, supone un interesante reto en cuanto a la reutilización de residuos para generar energía, contribuyendo de esta forma al objetivo de conseguir una economía circular, del residuo al recurso. Contribuirá a resolver el problema de acumulación de basura en los vertederos y por lo tanto su temprana colmatación y contaminación medioambiental, mediante la integración de una unidad de Gasificación y otra de Fischer-Tropsch para transformar la fracción biomásica de los residuos sólidos urbanos en bioenergía.

**Visits to the Algimia Plant of Alfara in 2017**

The visits to the Valorization Plant of Algimia de Alfara, headquarters of the LIFE Waste2Biofuel project, increased to 2,870 visitors in 2017.

Among the public that visits the facilities, there is a large number of students from colleges and institutes. Through these excursions they learn what is the process that the waste they generate in their own homes follow, since 80% of the visits are of inhabitants of the populations that form the Palancia-Belcaire consortium. The other 20% come from populations of the provinces of Castellón and Valencia, as in previous years.
